Helsby Community Link Hub - Progress Report

The volunteer drive has been very successful and the team combination of church and community volunteers have been meeting regularly to discuss plans, agree objectives, form a safer recruitment process for new volunteers and take the necessary steps towards opening.

The Hub plans to open officially on Monday 11th September, although it has already helped a couple of people who presented during the planning stages. The intention is start softly and adapt to the needs of the local community. The food pantry is in place and is well stocked and will work in partnership with West Cheshire Foodbank.

To develop volunteer training, we have joined the Cheshire West Voluntary Action group who run monthly courses on various subjects and we continue to expand our network and form relationships with other support groups in the area to effectively signpost people to the most appropriate service.

The next team meeting is on Monday 4th September at 12.00 midday for a familiarisation session prior to opening and to discuss options for promoting the Hub.
